On May 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

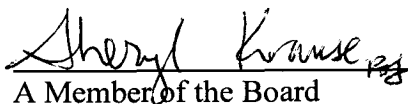
On November 8, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure or a reduction in the number of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license (#130654-30) to full, unrestricted status or a reduction in drug screens is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the Order (5/6/2010).
