On May 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On December 13, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in frequency of drug and alcohol screens, termination of AA/NA meetings, and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens, termination of AA/NA meetings, and access to controlled substances are DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance (i.e. missed check-ins and test). Respondent needs to fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the Board Order (5/6/2010).
