On June 21, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Reinstatement of Limited Licensure ("Order"), reinstating Respondent's surrendered professional nursing license and suspending it indefinitely. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

The Board designee has considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 36 per year.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
