On June 2, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On March 8, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for full licensure is hereby DENIED.
2. The Board GRANTS a reduction in screens. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
3. The Board GRANTS termination of direct supervision.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
