On July 21, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("July 21, 2011 Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, compliance with certain practice limitations. The July 21, 2011 Order further states that the Board in its discretion may impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms.

On June 14, 2018, the Board determined Respondent to be in violation of the July 21, 2011 Order by failing to abide by practice limitations specified in the Order. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

#### **ORDER**

- Respondent's professional nursing license (#115312-30) is further LIMITED as 1. follows:
  - Within fourteen (14) days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall a. provide a report to the Department Monitor of her current employment status, if any, and shall inform the Department Monitor of any applications submitted by Respondent for employment as a nurse since April 9, 2018 to the present.
  - b. Within forty-five (45) days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall provide a report to the Department Monitor identifying any and all applications submitted by Respondent for employment as a nurse since the most recent report.

In the event Respondent fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the July 21, 2011 Order and/or this Order, Respondent's license will be SUSPENDED by the Board or its designee, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms in a manner satisfactorily to the Board.
