On July 29, 2013, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's dentistry license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On August 1, 2018, the Board monitoring liaison considered Respondent's request for the return of full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's dentistry (#5583-15) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
