On July 18, 2012, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. ORDER

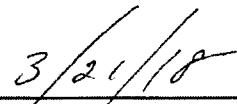
1. Respondent's request for the return of his license to practice medicine and surgery (#34488-20) to full, unrestricted status is hereby GRANTED.
