On September 12, 2012, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (Order) suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On January 9, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. The Board hereby GRANTS Respondent a reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for the return of his pharmacist license (#9573-40) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED. Respondent must work under the current terms of the Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
