On January 10, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including providing a hair or urine sample upon request and providing reports. On January 23, 2015, Respondent's license was suspended for failing to submit a hair sample upon request and consequently, failing to provide a drug screen report.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now provided a hair sample and drug screen report, the following is entered:

1. The suspension of Respondent's practical nursing license (#314512-31) is terminated.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
