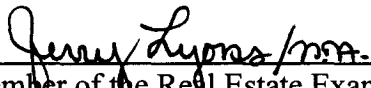
On February 4, 2013, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), which granted Applicant a limited real estate salesperson license with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, Applicant's license may be suspended, without further notice or hearing, for failure to submit quarterly reports as ordered.

Information has been received that demonstrates Applicant has been working as a real estate salesperson without submitting quarterly reports and is therefore in violation of the terms of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:
