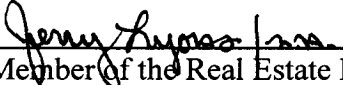
On February 4, 2013, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), which granted Applicant a limited real estate salesperson license with certain terms and conditions. On October 5, 2018, Applicant's license was suspended for violation of the Order.

Applicant has submitted a request for termination of the suspension, and full unrestricted licensure. Based on the information of record, which includes proof that Applicant has completed the terms of the Order, the Board's designee finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. The suspension is terminated and Applicant's real estate salesperson license (#76774-94) is hereby returned to full unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Applicant's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
