On August 14, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On August 15, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of the Order and the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of the Order and the return of his license to practice medicine and surgery (#24871-20) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous, successful compliance with the terms of the Order for at least five years. The Board will not consider further petitions until August 14, 2019.
