On July 11, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug and alcohol monitoring program.

On May 16, 2018, the Board designee considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than thirty-six (36) urine screens per year.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
