On September 18, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent was granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 19, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board makes the following:

1. Respondent's request for the return of her license to practice medicine and surgery (#38775-21) to full, unrestricted status is hereby GRANTED.
