On January 9, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), granting Applicant a limited professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, the Board in its discretion may impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of the Order.

Information has been received that demonstrates Applicant is in violation of the terms of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

- 1. Applicant's professional nursing license (#199878-30) is hereby SUSPENDED for violations of sections 3.b. and 3.g. The suspension is in effect pending Board receipt and review of an Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse (AODA) assessment and fitness to practice assessment with an evaluator pre-approved by the Board. The evaluator must have experience evaluating and treating health care professionals. The assessments should address, but are not limited to:
 - A. History of any prior substance and alcohol use, including any treatment or diagnoses, efforts to stop use and outcomes (if applicable);
 - B. Current readiness to change behavior;
 - C. General medical and psychiatric history;
 - D. Any family history of substance/alcohol use and psychiatric disorders (if applicable);
 - E. Social history (family and peer relationships, financial and legal problems);
 - F. Educational and occupational history;
 - G. Diagnosis, treatment recommendation(s) (if applicable); and
 - H. Professional opinion on Applicant's fitness to practice professional nursing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.001(4).
- 2. The Board may impose additional limitations based on the result of the assessments and evaluator's recommendations.

- The Board tables the request for work-site approval until the suspension is lifted. 3.
