On October 18, 2018, the Board reviewed Applicant's compliance history. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

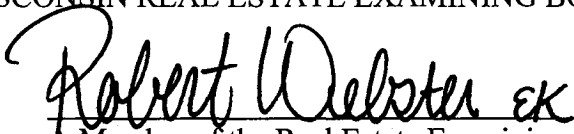
ORDER
