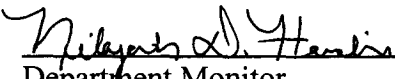
On August 27, 2014, the Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's psychologist license for an indefinite period commencing November 27, 2012, and continuing until Respondent completes six (6) hours of pre-approved education on the topic of "clinical self-assessment," six (6) hours on the topic of "ethics for psychology practice including identification of boundary crossing," and six (6) hours on the topic of "treating adult victims of childhood sexual abuse." Respondent was also ordered to pay the costs of the proceeding within 90 days.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education and submitted the payment for costs in full, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's expired psychologist license (#2614-57) is hereby terminated.
2. All encumbrances imposed upon Respondent's credential pursuant to the Order are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
