On September 9, 2014, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order No. 0003368 ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional counselor license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions. After one year from the date of the initial stay of suspension, Respondent may petition the Section for modification of the limitations on an annual basis per the Order.

On June 26, 2018, the Section considered Respondent's request for removal of the practice limitation relating to the treatment of male clients. Based upon the information of record, the Section finds and makes the following:

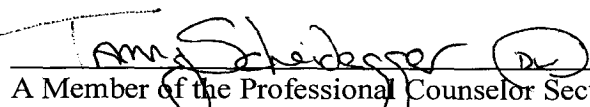
ORDER

1. Respondent's request for removal of the practice limitation relating to the treatment of male clients is hereby DENIED. Respondent has not demonstrated compliance through supervised practice in treating male clients per the Order.
