On December 4, 2014, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent Palermo to pay \$515.00 in costs of the proceeding, pay a \$500 forfeiture, and complete an education course on trust accounts, all within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent Palermo has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding, to pay the forfeiture, and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent Palermo's real estate broker license in the state of Wisconsin (#55840-90) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent Palermo has paid the costs of the proceeding and the forfeiture in full, as well as has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
