On December 11, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On August 9, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in screens, reduction in treatment per treater, termination of C.23., and termination of C.26. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 14 per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for reduction in frequency of AODA therapy sessions from one per month to one per two months per treater recommendation is GRANTED.
3. Respondent's request for termination of C.23. and C.26. is hereby DENIED for insufficient time under the modified Board Order (7/20/2017) to demonstrate adequate compliance.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
