On December 11, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 10, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, reduction of AA/NA meetings, and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens and access to controlled substances is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 36 screens per year.
- 2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings is hereby DENIED. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Board Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
