On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 14, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in alcohol and drug screens, termination of AODA therapy and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in alcohol and drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent is required to test at a frequency of not less than 36 screens per year.
2. Respondent's request for termination of AODA therapy is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Board Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
