On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On August 9, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug screens, a reduction in AA/NA meetings, and termination of direct supervision when working in a facility without controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens, reduction in AA/NA meetings and termination of direct supervision when working in a facility without controlled substances is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than fourteen (14) per year and one annual hair test, and AA/NA meetings are reduced to one per week.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
