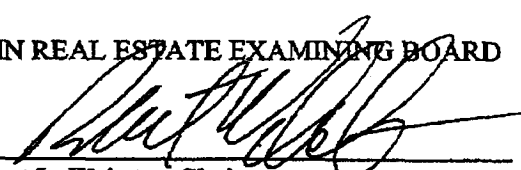
After considering the Applicant's request for removal of the limitations and full, unrestricted license the following is ordered:
