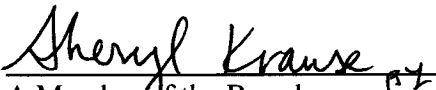
On March 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order"), suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On August 9, 2018, the Board considered Applicant's request for acceptance of primary monitoring duties including drug and alcohol testing through Minnesota's Health Professionals Services Program ("HPSP") Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

1. Applicant's request for Minnesota HPSP to take over primary monitoring including drug testing is hereby GRANTED.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
