On March 18, 2015, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 4, 2018, the Board designee considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. Respondent needs to fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the original Board Order.
