On May 18, 2015, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") granted Applicant a limited real estate salesperson license in the state of Wisconsin. Pursuant to the Order Granting Limited License ("Order") issued on the same date, Applicant may petition the Board for removal of the limitations upon the completion of at least two years of practice in compliance with all terms and conditions of the Order.

On October 18, 2018 the Board considered Applicant's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:
