On July 9, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

Information submitted in support of Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens has been reviewed. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent is eligible for a temporary reduction at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test until she obtains employment as a professional nurse, at which time the frequency will be increased to not less than 49 screens per year.
2. Respondent's request for a permanent reduction in screens once the Respondent has obtained approved nursing employment is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
