On October 8, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 10, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for reduction in screens, termination of AA/NA meetings and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 28 urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
2. Respondent's requests for termination of AA/NA meetings and access to controlled substances are hereby DENIED. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the conditions of the modified Board Order before the Board will consider amending other requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
