On January 5, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), granting Applicant a limited professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions.

On August 9, 2018, the Board considered Applicant's request for a reduction in screens to eighteen (18) per year; termination of AA/NA verification logs; ability to work in home health, pool-nursing and agency settings; and a reduction in treatment sessions. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in treatment sessions to two per year per Treater recommendation is hereby GRANTED.

2. Respondent's request for a reduction in screens to eighteen (18) per year, termination of AA/NA verification logs, and the ability to work in home health, pool-nursing and agency settings is hereby DENIED for insufficient time under the Board Order (1/5/2016) to demonstrate adequate compliance. In the alternative, the Board grants a reduction of screens to not less than thirty-six (36) per year.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
