On February 17, 2016, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete four (4) hours of education in each of the following topics: neurology, geriatrics, medical record keeping and communication, within nine (9) months. On March 5, 2018, Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.

Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements for medical record keeping and communication. Respondent has also submitted proof of enrollment in courses to complete the education requirement for neurology and geriatrics. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery (#19558-20) is hereby TERMINATED.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
