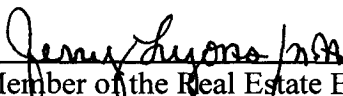
On March 28, 2016 the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") granted Applicant a limited real estate salesperson license in the state of Wisconsin. Pursuant to the Order Granting Limited Certificate of Registration ("Order") issued on March 21, 2016, Applicant may petition the Department Monitor for removal of the limitations upon the completion of at least two years of practice in compliance with all terms and conditions of the Order.

On October 5, 2018, the Board's designee considered Applicant's request for full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board's designee finds and makes the following:

1. Applicant's request for full unrestricted licensure as a real estate salesperson license (#81773-94) is hereby GRANTED.
