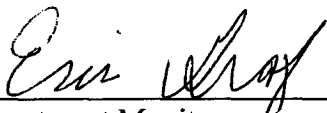
On April 14, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete six (6) hours of education in "Ethics and Professionalism," two (2) hours in "Nurse Practice Acts," and five (5) hours in "Documentation" within 90 days. Respondent was also required to pay \$550.00 in costs of the proceeding as ordered. On December 2, 2016, Respondent's professional nursing license was suspended for failure to complete the education and failure to pay the costs of the proceeding as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education and paid the costs of the proceeding in full, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's professional nursing license (#169148-30) is terminated.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
