On April 19, 2016, the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Respondent's clinical social worker license for an indefinite period and adding limitations to the credential. On September 15, 2017, the Section issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Limitations ("Order") which added additional limitations to Respondent's credential.

On October 23, 2018, the Section considered Respondent's request for termination of supervision and treatment requirements. Based upon the information of record, the Section finds the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of the supervision requirements outlined in Section 5 (a.), (e.), (f.), (g.) and (h.) of the Order is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for termination of the treatment requirements outlined in Sections 3 and 4 of the Order is hereby GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
