On July 8, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order") granting Applicant a limited professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions.

Information submitted in support of Applicant's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens has been reviewed. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Applicant is eligible for a reduction at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Applicant's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Applicant's frequency is reduced to not less than fourteen (14) screens per year and one (1) annual hair test until he obtains employment as a professional nurse, at which time the frequency will be increased to not less than thirty-six (36) screens per year.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
