On September 8, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (Order) suspending Respondent's Registered Nurse license and her Advanced Practice Nurse Prescriber certificate with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the terms of the Order, on December 28, 2016, the Board terminated Respondent's suspensions and imposed additional limitations based on the results of her fitness to practice assessment.

On April 12, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her credentials to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her Registered Nurse license (#156419-30) and Advanced Practice Nurse Prescriber certificate 5675-33) to full, unrestricted status is hereby GRANTED.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credentials are hereby removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
