On October 19, 2016, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license with certain terms and conditions, including the completion of twelve (12) hours of education on the topic of "anger management" and twelve (12) hours of education on the topic of "professional boundaries" within nine (9) months. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements, and as a result, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's anesthesiologist assistant license (#22-17) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
