On November 3, 2016, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (Order) suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 27, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request to work independently for ten (10) hours in a twenty-one (21) day period. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request to work independently is hereby GRANTED. Respondent may work without the presence of another pharmacist for a total of sixteen (16) hours every two (2) weeks.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
