On November 10, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's 129892-30 for an indefinite period. Respondent was granted an immediate stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 19, 2018, the Board Monitoring Liaison considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 36 per year.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
