On January 5, 2017, the Wisconsin Professional Land Surveyor Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers, and Professional Land Surveyors ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's land surveyor license with certain terms and conditions.

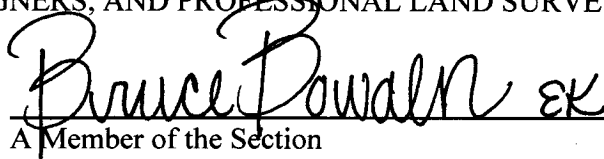
