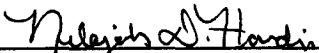
On February 2, 2017, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$580.00 in costs of the proceeding and complete six (6) hours of education on the topic of real estate contracts, both within 90 days from the date of the Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's real estate salesperson license (#79157-94) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full and has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
