On February 13, 2017, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional counselor training license with certain terms and conditions, including continued counseling and biweekly Al-Anon meetings. After one year, Respondent may petition for removal of the counseling and Al-Anon attendance limitations upon providing a favorable recommendation from her counselor.

Information submitted in support of Respondent's request for removal of the counseling and Al-Anon attendance limitations has been reviewed. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for removal of the limitation relating to continued bi-weekly counseling, as outlined in provision 4 a. of the Order, has been GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for removal of the limitation relating to Al-Anon or other community support group attendance, as outlined in provision 4.b. of the Order, has been GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
