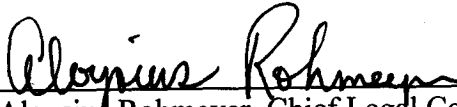
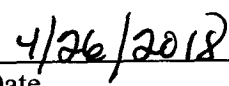
On February 23, 2017, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), which granted Mr. Fullerton a limited dwelling contractor qualifier certificate with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, Mr. Fullerton's license may be suspended, without further notice or hearing, until Mr. Fullerton has complied with the terms of the Order.

Information has been received that demonstrates Mr. Fullerton has not submitted quarterly reports and has not made monetary payments as required by the terms of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:
