On March 9, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions.

On October 11, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens and access to controlled substances is DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. Respondent needs to fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the original Board Order (3/9/2017).
