On April 6, 2017, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's Pharmacist license with certain terms and conditions. After the first year from the date of the Order, Respondent may petition the Board, on an annual basis, for modification of the terms of the Order.

On May 24, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than thirty-six (36) screens per year and two annual hair tests.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
