
On May 11, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order"), limiting Respondent's professional nursing license and advanced practice nurse prescriber certificate with certain terms and conditions, including education requirements, costs of the proceeding, written acknowledgement from her employer, and quarterly work reports. Pursuant to the Order, Respondent's license and certificate may be suspended, without further notice or hearing, for violation of any of the terms of the Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the terms of the Order and as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#136584-30) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. Respondent's advanced practice nurse prescriber certificate (#3968-33) is hereby SUSPENDED.
3. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent demonstrates compliance with the terms of the Order.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
