On June 13, 2017, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") granted Applicant a limited real estate salesperson license in the state of Wisconsin. Pursuant to the Order Granting Limited License ("Order") issued on the same date, Applicant may petition the Board for removal of the limitations upon the completion of at least one year of practice in compliance with all terms and conditions of the Order.
