On August 16, 2017, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for seven (7) consecutive days and limiting it with certain terms and conditions.

On September 19, 2018, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of his license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board makes the following:
