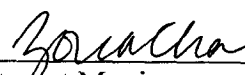

On September 11, 2107, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay a total forfeiture in the amount of \$250 within thirty (30) days. On November 14, 2017, Respondent was granted a payment plan of \$50 per month. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the forfeiture as ordered and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's cosmetology license (#90216-82) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the forfeiture in full.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
