On November 15, 2017, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery. Respondent was required to complete eight (8) hours of education on the topic of professional ethics, and eight (8) hours of education on the topic of coding/billing, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education, and as a result, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery (#40180-20) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
